The following details relate to an educational excursion to **Lanyon Homestead Excursion** which is being organised for **Year 4**.

Purpose of Excursion:	As part of our learning about Australia's history, including convict settlement, students in Year 4 will be going on an excursion to Lanyon Homestead to further their understanding through practical experiences. This program introduces students to the landscape, convict-built buildings and historical objects of that era. Students will explore how historians use sources of evidence to interpret the past and reflect upon how knowledge of histories are constructed. During this excursion, students will take on the role of a Lanyon convict in this role play program that provides hands-on experience of convict life.
